From 1963 to the future

The company was created in the heart of Odense, Denmark in 1963 by Mogens A. Stærmose. Over the years, various products for garden life were produced and sold, and at the beginning of the 70s, the first greenhouse was manufactured and distributed from the facilities in Odense. After some years, the company changed its name to 'Juliana Drivhuse' (Greenhouses), focusing on producing residential greenhouses.

For many years, the primary use of the greenhouse was cultivating in connection with vegetable gardens, as many remember it from the grandparents' garden. Over time the greenhouse has moved from the back of the garden closer to the house and the patio because people have realised that the greenhouse can function as a micro-climate for both people and plants. Modern design and materials have been a part of this journey.

More than 60 years after the company was established, it is still family owned by the third generation Nikolaj Stærmose. We hope that greenhouses, for many years to come, will be a room for star moments in the garden worldwide. This is why we say 'We Help People Grow'.





In the Grand Oase the double stable doors are located on the long side of the greenhouse, creating an airy feel and easy access thanks to the low threshold.

The sides are almost two metres high and together with the pyramid shaped roof structure the greenhouse offers plenty of space. You can easily divide the space with cultivation on one side and a sitting area in the other and enjoy easy access to both.

The Juliana Grand Oase 25,6 is constructed with an aluminium frame that enhances the construction. Because of this, there is no need for collar beams, giving the greenhouse an extra spacious feeling.



Cresting

For the models with the classic greenhouse roof, it is possible to purchase the attractive and practical cresting. Cresting was originally developed to prevent birds from roosting on the roof. At the same time, it gives the greenhouse a classic look.







Gutter with Leaf Guard

Integrated into the gutter is a leaf guard that ensures a minimal amount of leaves and easy cleaning of the downpipes and gutter. The plastic catch in the gutter ends latch the flap. The downpipe has a diameter of 40 mm and is attached directly to the gutter.

Details that give the finishing touch.Metal fittings, cover plates, nut protectors etc., completes the greenhouse.

Double stable door

Keep the lower parts of the stable door closed to keep uninvited large and small animals away and the upper part open for ventilation.



Intelligent and elegant ventilation

The cowl on the Oase and Grand Oase has beeswax-filled cylinders. The heat in the greenhouse expands the beeswax in the cylinders, and the cowl is raised and ensures the necessary ventilation.



Door handle with integrated lock

The door is provided with a door handle in stainless steel with an integrated lock.



Low threshold for easy access

The door has a low threshold, which levels the entrance and provides easy access for wheelchairs, wheelbarrows and small carts.



Strong aluminium profiles

The robust profile construction supports the fact that the greenhouses are developed and tested for Scandinavian weather conditions. When toughened glass or polycarbonate panels are glued to the profiles with silicone, significant strength is achieved, helping to stabilize the entire structure and make the greenhouse extra strong. The powder-coated profiles undergo continuous tests, meeting internationally recognized standards and are covered by our 12-year warranty.








Danish craftsmanship and great precision

During manufacturing, the steel bases for the greenhouses are rolled and cut to size, and the aluminum profiles are cut or CNC-processed to the specific models and sizes.

Manufacturing a greenhouse requires precision and, to some degree, manual handling, and packing. Where possible, we automate and invest in machinery and packing robots which is a necessary investment to ensure that production and employees stay in Denmark.

BEFORE BUYING A GREENHOUSE

A greenhouse typically stays in the garden for many years, so it is important to find out what is right in terms of needs and wishes.

Size - Think not only of the base area but also the height

It is important to consider how big the greenhouse should be. In this connection the height of the greenhouse is relevant as well. A greenhouse with a side height of at least 150 cm and a total height of more than 2 m gives a good room feel. You can stand upright, both when you work in the greenhouse with your plants or if you use the greenhouse as an extra room.

Grow, relax - or both

The choice of greenhouse size depends first and foremost on the amount of space in the garden and where the house is to be placed. But it is also important to make clear what the greenhouse is going to be used for. Should you relax or grow tomatoes and herbs - or both?

Dinner party or time alone

If you want to invite the whole family for dinner in the green-house when the weather does not allow you to sit under the open sky, then you will need more space. Having said that, you do not need a large greenhouse to make room for a dining area. It is about taking advantage of the space in the right way.

Herbs or giant pumpkins

Think about what you want to grow. Are there crops that require space? Many people underestimate the space needed for growing and buy a greenhouse that is too small. But once you get started and have been addicted to picking home-grown cucumbers and tomatoes, you will easily want to expand the range. So think about what you will grow. Do you just want herbs, or do you want more and larger crops?

Four or more sides

Greenhouses come in many shapes. The classic shape is the rectangular greenhouse, but there are also other designs, such as a lean-to, a pavilion style, or an orangery. In terms of cultivating, a tomato thrives as well in a round as in a square greenhouse. So it is an individual assessment and depends on personal taste and style.

Glass or polycarbonate

Glass is the most beautiful solution, while polycarbonate is the most practical.

Toughened glass, also called safety glass has the advantage that if it breaks, it crumbles into small pieces and not in large sharp pieces, like ordinary greenhouse glass. Polycarbonate has an insulating effect and reduces the big differences in day and night temperatures, and therefore the greenhouse is easier to keep frost free during winter.

In the Juliana range we have chosen that all models are offered with long pane toughened glass and some models are also offered with polycarbonate. With the long pane toughened glass, you don't have to worry about algae that often occur with glass overlaps.

Toughened glass also has the advantage that it is far stronger than ordinary greenhouse glass. Our toughened glass is 3 mm thick and has great flexibility on the surfaces. The strength against blows and pressure is illustrated in this video about the different types of glass and their strength.

When the glass is glued to the profiles with silicone, the construction is stabilized, and you get a strong greenhouse ready to resist most challenges.

Profiles – aluminum or painted

The traditional hobby greenhouse was originally made of aluminium. But much has happened over the years, and in the Juliana range we now offer some of the models in both untreated aluminium and powder coated anthracite-colored aluminium. The Orangeri, Oase, and Grand Oase models are solely offered in anthracite, and the Jubii 60 is produced in black. All variants come with black windows and doors. Whether you want the traditional aluminium or the dark gray look depends on your personal taste.

The Urban range is produced in black-colored aluminium.



Cresting

Roof decoration - also called cresting - was originally developed to prevent birds from roosting on the roof. At the same time, it gives the greenhouse a classic look. Whether you wish to have roof decoration on your greenhouse is entirely up to you. In the Juliana range, cresting can be added to Compact, Premium, Gartner, Jubii 60 and Orangeri.

Base – make one yourself or buy one

A good base is important. First, it provides stability to the greenhouse, and most insurance only covers if the foundation is mounted correctly and concreted.

You can choose to build/concrete a foundation for your greenhouse, but we always recommend buying an original Juliana foundation consisting of precisely cut 12 cm high galvanized black-lacquered steel profiles.

Building permit

For building permission in relation to greenhouses, we recommend that you investigate local regulations.

With or without dwarf wall

Grand Oase 13,0 and 18,8 as well as Premium 13,0 are also available with shortened profiles, allowing you to establish the greenhouse with a fixed base. See pages 10 and 20-25. You will need to establish the foundation yourself and build a wall to anchor the greenhouse.

Materials for the wall solution are not included with the green-house. The wall is a 'build-it-yourself project' before the green-house can be assembled.

ASSEMBLY

Assembling and erecting a greenhouse is a 'do-it-yourself' task. Alternatively, you can choose to buy assembly. Juliana Greenhouses can refer to installers that you can contact.

If you choose to complete the assembly work, you usually have to spend 2-3

days with a 'normal' greenhouse, and you must plan the task realistically. E.g. place the base firmly on a level surface and wait for the concrete to dry before assembling the house itself. At **Juliana.** com (Help&Support) you will find videos that will help you through the construction process.

If you choose to purchase assembly, we recommend that you order the installation when the greenhouse has been delivered.



Place halved tomatoes cut side up on a baking sheet with greaseproof paper. Sprinkle the salt, oil, balsamic vinegar, sugar and herbs over the tomatoes and bake them at 120 degrees C for 2-3 hours until they shrivel and most of the water in the tomatoes has evaporated. Allow to cool and place them in cleaned sterilized jars and pour a good oil over so the tomatoes are completely covered.


